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Writing Intensive Requirement: Course Title/# ENGL 401 _____ WI course in major _____ 600/700-level WI course _____ other WI course _____	All undergraduates are required to complete four "writing- intensive" courses which must include English 401(First-Year Writing) and three additional "writing- intensive" courses, one of which must be in the student's major and one must be at the 600-level or above. A student may take a 600/700 level WI course in the major but must still have a total of four WI courses.
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*One of the two sciences (BS, PS) must have a lab.

 ***May be taken to fulfill a World Culture requirement if an intermediate-level course is used.

Communication Arts - 40 credits

Majors must complete 10 courses (40 credits). Transfer students must complete at least 20 credits in the CA major at UNHM. CMN 455, 456, 457 must be completed with a grade of C or better. All other courses in the major must be completed with a grade of C- or better and an overall gpa in the major of 2.0 or better.

The capstone requirement will be satisfied in a student's senior year by completion of a specific four-credit capstone course at the 600 or 700 level. Students may not enroll in a capstone course until they have completed all three CA program core courses (CMN 455, 456 and 457) and all CA Area A and Area B requirements. The capstone course can also fulfill an Area C course requirement. Courses that satisfy this requirement include but are not limited to : CA 601, CA 612, CA 614, CA 615, CA 720, and CA 795.
