To Do:

- Complete the application process through the Admissions Office, 88 Commercial Street, Manchester, NH, 03101 • manchester.unh.edu or unhm.admissions@unh.edu
Office location is 88 Commercial Street, Manchester, NH
- Submit on line application for FAFSA - Free Application for Student Aid <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/>.
- Apply for your GI Bill®. Go to www.gibill.va.gov and select “Apply for Benefits”.
- Give UNH Manchester Office (Student Accounts) a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility. Once the VA processes your application for benefits, they will send you a Certificate of Eligibility. Keep a copy for your own records, and submit a copy to the UNH Manchester Student Accounts Office in Student Service Suite at 88 Commercial Street, Manchester.
- Submit the UNH Veterans Enrollment Certification Request. This form is available on our website at manchester.unh.edu/student/veterans-services. This form can be submitted up to 4 months prior to the first day of the semester, and must be submitted every semester that you intend to use benefits.
- Attend an on-campus Orientation, call 641-4170 to register.
- Schedule a meeting with an Advisor, register for your classes, and come to see Jennifer in Student Accounts office for your certification.
- If you are a Guard or Reservist, and you have questions about benefits, call Jennifer at 641-4329.
