

## Neuropsychology Program Scholarship Application

The Neuropsychology Scholarship is a merit-based award recognizing high achieving students enrolled in the Bachelor of Arts Neuropsychology program at UNH Manchester. The amount of the award is \$1,500. The number of scholarships awarded each year will be based on University funding. To be considered for the award, students must complete a scholarship application, have an overall GPA of 3.2 or higher, and have a GPA of 3.2 or higher within the Neuropsychology program.

Additionally, student's positive engagement in Neuropsychology classes, academic integrity, as well as a demonstrated interest in the field of Neuropsychology through community service, research projects, and/or professional experience will be considered. The Neuropsychology Scholarship is merit-based and will only be given in only those years when an applicant meets all of the award criteria.
