

Biological Sciences Program Scholarship Application

The Biological Sciences Scholarship is a merit-based award recognizing high achieving students enrolled in the Bachelor of Arts in Biological Sciences at UNH Manchester. The amount of the award is \$1,500. The number of scholarships awarded each year will be based on University funding. To be considered for the award, students must complete a scholarship application and fulfill the following academic requirements: have an overall GPA of 3.2 or higher, have at least a total of 32 earned credits, and have successfully completed Principles of Biology I and II or equivalent courses. Additionally, the student's positive engagement in Biology classes, academic integrity, research projects, and/or professional experience will be considered. Because the Biological Sciences Scholarship is merit-based, it will be given in only those years when an applicant meets all of the award criteria.
