This scholarship is non-renewable, and past recipients are not eligible.

The Homeland Security Scholarship is a merit-based award recognizing high achieving students enrolled in the Bachelor of Science Homeland Security program at UNH Manchester. A total of \$1,500 is available, which may be awarded as a single award, or may be divided into two or three smaller awards. To be considered for an award, students must complete a scholarship application and have an overall <u>GPA of 3.2 or higher</u>. Other factors considered when selecting a recipient include: academic achievement within the major and quality of essay.
