Program Notes:

- All students must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA in order to graduate. Students must achieve a GPA of 2.5 or better in major courses.
- Senior Residency: students must complete their last 32 credits of the degree at UNH.
- Students may take any undergraduate courses as electives in order to earn a minimum of 128 credits.
- Courses applied to the major must be completed with a minimum grade of C. Students who earn less than a C in a particular course may repeat that course only once.
- Transfer students must complete a minimum of 8 major courses at UNHM.
