### Complimentary Block of Courses (40 Credits)

In addition to the core HLS courses, students must complete 40 additional credits in one of five ways:

1. two minors;
2. a minor and a “coherent block”/self-designed concentration approved by the HLS coordinator;
3. a second major;
4. an associate’s degree transferred into UNH;
5. some other combination of coursework with consent of the HLS program coordinator.

Please consult your faculty advisor to discuss your complimentary block of courses. Indicate below your plan to complete this requirement.

#### Program Notes:

- All students must have at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA in order to graduate.
- Senior Residency: students must complete their last 32 credits of the degree at UNH.
- Students may take any undergraduate courses as electives in order to earn a minimum of 128 credits.
- Courses applied to the major must be completed with a minimum grade of C- and overall GPA of 2.0 or above in major courses.
