- Transfer students must complete at least 24 credits in Psychology at UNH or UNH Manchester.
- Students with a major in psychology may not use any major course to satisfy the Discovery requirements.
- Of the four 700 level courses required for the major, at least 3 must be taken at UNH.

Foreign Language Policy:
