The objective of the Minor in Communication Arts is to provide students with a knowledge base that not only approximates the overall range of communication practices included in the Communication Arts major, but also gives students the opportunity to select several courses that may be of special interest to them or that may more directly complement their major field of study or enhance their professional interests. This form must be completed prior to beginning coursework leading to the Minor in Communication Arts and a copy submitted to the Academic Counseling Office and Prof. Klenotic. Upon completion of the coursework, the student must resubmit the original form with all course information noted and signed by the student's Major Advisor and the Minor Supervisor. The Minor in Communication Arts will appear on the student's academic record when all the necessary courses have been completed.

The Communication Arts Minor requires the completion of five courses, 20 credits, according to the guidelines below. An overall GPA of 2.00 in minor courses is required, with no individual grade lower than C-. Students should work with their advisors to insure that any prerequisites for 500 level courses have been met, or that permission to enter the courses has been granted by the appropriate course instructor. Courses used to satisfy General Education/Discovery requirements may also be used to satisfy CA minor requirements. No more than two courses (8 credits maximum) will be permitted to transfer into the CA major from other institutions. Transfer courses must be reviewed by the Minor Supervisor.
